Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) set goals and targets about the world we should aim for by 2030, and this also address global challenge of waste management which are envisaged in SDG 11.6 on urban pollution reduction, 12.4 on environmentally sound management of hazardous waste and 12.5 on recycling. There are sets of indicators measure the progress which are:

- SDG indicator **11.6.1**: Proportion of municipal solid waste collected and managed in controlled facilities out of total municipal solid waste generated, by cities;
- SDG indicator **12.4.2**: Hazardous waste generated per capita and proportion of hazardous waste treated, by type of treatment; and
- SDG indicator **12.5.1**: National recycling rate, tones of material recycled

UN-Habitat and UN Environment have pilot tested the Waste SDG indicators monitoring methodology in Kenya and Cameroon and refined data collection methodology especially for SDG 11.6.1 and 12.5.1. The training workshop aims to equip ACCP members with the monitoring methodology for SDG 11.6.1 and 12.5 so that members.
